COMMITMENT TO YOUTH

Children are an important part of the cooperative community. Each year, Oregon’s electric cooperatives donate \$59,900 in scholarships to young people. Co-ops spend another \$43,450 annually sending young people from their community to the national Youth Leadership Conference, science camps, energy seminars, 4-H programs and

provide career development opportunities. They also provide regular electric safety demonstrations to school children and their parents.

Co-ops help support a variety of school programs ranging from renewable energy projects to athletic programs — and in one case even provided funding for a school nurse. They regularly donate items, such as computers and drafting equipment and provide assistance to schools through energy efficiency incentives and lighting rebates. ■
